

CHECKLIST

Everything You Need for a DIY Thin Brick Project

Adhesive

Options:

Dry mix

(We recommend Old Mill Adhesive.)

Modified thin set

Type 1 mastic-only

(Interior use only.)

Bucket

(It can be used to mix all three dry materials.)

Mixing paddle

Drop cloth

(Not necessary for floor applications.)

Sanding sponge

(For surface prep.)

Grout

Options:

Sanded tile grout

S-Type mortar

Grout float

(For floor application.)

Grout bag

(Only necessary for wall applications. We recommend using the floating grout method for floors.)

Level

(To ensure straight lines.)

Notched trowel

(To spread adhesive.)

Margin trowel

(To mix, scoop and spread materials in tight corners.)

Brick cutter

(Use an angle grinder or a wet tile saw.)

Brick jointer

(Only if doing a concave grout style.)

Spacers or dowels

(If using single bricks.)

Cleaning sponge or masonry brush

Sealant

(Optional, but heavily recommended for flooring. We recommend the 511 Impregnator Sealant by Miracle.)
